I am writing to clarify expectations for uniform for the coming academic year.

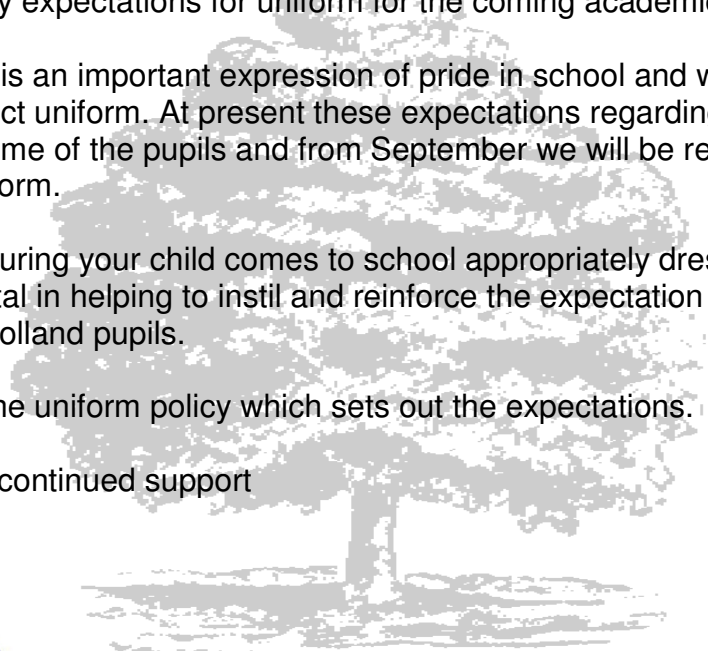

School uniform policy

Children are expected to wear Holland Junior School uniform at all times during the school year. The uniform has been kept very simple and inexpensive, so that it is easy to find and buy. Parents are expected to send their children into school correctly dressed, in clean uniform, and we ask that you inform us by telephone or in writing if for any reason the appropriate school uniform cannot be worn. We do recognise that there may be difficulties due to finance and wearing out the old uniform. If these occur please contact the Head teacher who will be happy to discuss solutions.

Children may wear a single pair of stud type earrings that they must be able to take out for PE and games. **Parents must only allow their children to pierce their ears at the beginning of the summer holiday.** This ensures children are fully able to participate in PE at the beginning of September (i.e. the earrings can be removed without the ear closing up). No other jewellery may be worn to school, though children may wear watches.

Haircuts should be sensible – tram lines, mohicans and dyed hair are not permitted. Children with long hair (touching shoulders) must wear their hair tied back or plait it for reasons of health and safety. All items of uniform may be purchased from the school office.

Please label every single article of clothing your child wears clearly and permanently. Without your child's name in their clothing they are unlikely to get it back when they lose it!

Children are expected to wear winter uniform from the second half of the Autumn Term through until the end of the first half of the Spring Term. Summer uniform can be worn between the start of the second half of the Spring Term and the end of the first half of the Autumn Term.

Grey school skirt (no longer than just below the knee) or grey tailored school trousers. No black clothing.	Green and white all over checked summer dress (not culottes) or grey skirt/trousers as for winter uniform.
School jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt with logo	School jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt with logo
(Years 5 and 6) White school shirt with school tie. A tie must be worn with the shirt.	(Years 5 and 6) As for winter uniform if not wearing summer dress. If wearing the white school shirt a tie must be worn.
(Years 3 and 4) White polo shirt with school logo - not a tee shirt.	(Year 3 and 4) As for winter uniform with a white polo shirt if not wearing summer dress.
Grey knee length socks or grey or green tights.	With summer dress – knee length or ankle length white socks. (no trainer socks/liners)
Black school shoes. No boots or trainers.	Black school shoes. No boots or trainers.
